and forty two in order to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred dollars due 23<sup>rd</sup> day Nov 1837 fifty five dollars due 25<sup>th</sup> Decr 1840 to the said Jacob Williams and Sampson Pope did by indenture of trust of that date convey to the said Thomas D'Knight his heirs Executors &c the following property, to wit one hundred forty seven & a half acres more or less, upon trust, for the uses and purposes in the said indenture mentioned, and whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust the said Mills L Gray hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope the sum of money therby secured which the said Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope doth hereby acknowledge, that for the considerations aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Mills L Gray to the said Thomas D'Knight at and before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Thomas D'Knight with the absent and approbation of the said Jacob Williams and Sampson Pope signified by his being party to these presents, and the said Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope have granted, bargained and sold, remised, released, and confirmed. And by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, remise, release and confirm, unto the said Mills L Gray all the estate, right title, interest, claim and demand, both at law and in equity which the said Thomas D'Knight and Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope have or hold in the land above described. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the said Mills L Gray his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Mills L Gray his heirs executors, administrators and assigns forever, and the said Thomas D'Knight and Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope for themselves their heirs executors and administrators, the above mentioned land, unto the said Mills L Gray his heirs executors, administrators and assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was warranted by the said Mills L Gray by the deed of trust aforesaid, do warrant the same to the said Mills L Gray against the claim or claims of them the said Thomas D'Knight and Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope and all persons claiming by or under them, or either of them, in witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands, and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
