well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Mills
& Gray to the said Thomas D Knight at and before the executing and delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Thomas
D Knight with the assent and approbation of the said Jacob Williams and
Sampson Pope signified by his being party to these presents, and the said
Jacob Williams and Sampson Pope have granted, bargained and sold,
remised, released, and confirmed, And by these presents do grant, bargain
and sell, remise, release and confirm, unto the said Mills & Gray, all the
estate, right title, interest, claim and demand, both at law and in equity
which the said Thomas D Knight and Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope
have or hold in the land above described. To have and to hold the
said tract or parcel of land to the said Mills & Gray his heirs, Exec.
administrators and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of
him the said (Mills & Gray) his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
forever, and the said Thomas D Knight and Jacob Williams & Sampson
Pope for themselves their heirs, executors and administrators the above mentioned
land, unto the said Mills & Gray his heirs, executors, administrators and
assigns in as full and ample manner as the same was warranted by
the said Mills & Gray by the deed of trust above recited, do warrant the
same to the said Mills & Gray against the claim or claims of him the said
Thomas D Knight and Jacob Williams & Sampson Pope and all persons
claiming by or under them, or either of them, In witness whereof the parties to
these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day
and year first above written.
