

Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas George A. M. Neeson and John H. Rockhill have been the said Lemuel P. Nicholson's security to a bond executed to John Jones due and payable on the first day of October next 1843, for the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars, and the said Lemuel P. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Lemuel P. Nicholson for and in consideration of the premises as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edwin D. Nash at or before the ensualing or delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Nicholson has granted, bargained and sold, and does by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Edwin D. Nash his heirs or assigns forever two certain brown Mares which he purchased of the said John Jones, to have & to hold the aforesaid Mares unto him the said trustee. Upon Trust. Notwithstanding if the said Nicholson shall pay and satisfy the said bond as aforesaid when it becomes payable so that no default of payment be made: otherwise by the said Edwin D. Nash shall be soon after the happening of such default of payment made when directed by the said Neeson or Rockhill, expose at public sale to the highest bidder for Cash the above named personal property as aforesaid; after fixing on the time and place and giving reasonable public notice thereof; and from the monies arising from such sale first pay all expenses attending such sale and this conveyance, Secondly pay and satisfy the bond as aforesaid, and the surplus of money pay over to the said Lemuel P.
