Chair, one spinning wheel and its appurtenances, three pair cotton cards, one shot gun,
four pine tables, one dozen earthen plates, two earthen dishes, two glass salt stands,
four earthen bowls, one set knives and forks, one set cups and saucers, one set tea spooms
two iron pots, and kettles, one spittoon and lid, one pair set irons, four tubs, one pail, two
trays, one raggin, and all other house hold and kitchen furniture not yet named if any
there be; also one long mare, one bridle and saddle, one harness, two augers, two chisels
, one drawing knife, one wead hor, the ensuing crop of corn, fodder, oats, Cotton, peas, beans
and all other crop not yet named if any threshed to also one sow and pigs and future
increase. So have and to hold the said hundre granted or intended to be granted prop-
erty unto the said Isfa A Williamson his executors administrators and assigns forever.
And the said Edmund Stephenson for himself his heirs executors & administrators
doth hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with the said Isfa A Williamson his
executors, administrators and assigns forever, in manner and form following that is to say,
that the said Edmund Stephenson his heirs executors and administrators the aforesaid
property or parcel of property so hundre conveyed unto the said Isfa A Williamson his
executors, administrators and assigns, against all person whatsoever, shall and will
warrant and forever defend by these presents, that the said Isfa A Williamson his heirs
executors and administrators shall permit the said Edmund Stephenson to remain in
quiet and peaceable possession of the said property, and take the profits there of to his
own use, until default be made in the payment of the said sum of one hundred and
seventy three dollars either in the whole or in part; and then upon this further trust,
that he or his executors or administrators shall and will so soon after the happening of
such default of payment as he may think proper or the said James Harris, his
executors, administrators or assigns request, sell the said property or aforesaid mentioned or
such part thereof as the trustee or his representative hundre authorized to act, shall
think sufficient for the purpose, and think proper to sell to the highest bidder for
ready money, at publick auction, after having fixed the time, and place of sale
at their own discretion and given fifteen days notice thereof at some publick place
by advertisement previous to the day of sale: And out of the monies arising from
such sale shall, after satisfying the charge thereof and all other expenses attending
said sale, pay to the said James Harris his heirs &c. the sum of one hundred and
seventy three dollars with the interest which may have accrued lawfully according
and the balance if any, shall pay to the said Edmund Stephenson his heirs &c.
But if the whole of the said sum of one hundred and seventy three dollars shall
be fully paid off and discharged to the said James Harris his heirs or assigns
or before the first day of November next, when the same is payable so
that no default of payment be made, then this Indenture to be void, and thence
