Drury, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that they the said John Vick and Amos Drury, in order to secure the said Arthur A. Drury, who is their security to the following p^roceedings and delivery bonds to wit. A bond executed by Vick and Drury to Samuel Paul and Edward Pogram merchants and partners under the style of Paul and Pogram for the sum of six hundred and fifty seven dollars and seventy eight cents, one other like bond executed by the same to James S. Bloodgood & James S. Ingles merchants and partners under the style of James S. Bloodgood & Co for the sum of one hundred and sixty seven dollars and twelve cents, one other like bond executed by the same to William B. Borough & Clark merchants and partners under the above firm, for the sum of five hundred and sixty two dollars, one other like bond executed by the same to Charles S. Wood and George S. Blood merchants and partners, under the firm and style of Wood and Blood, for the sum of four hundred and twenty dollars and forty cents, one other like bond executed by the same to the same for the sum of three hundred and sixty dollars and eighty seven cents, one other like bond executed by the same to John Crocker for the sum of four hundred and thirty four dollars and sixteen cents, one other like bond executed by the same to James S.
