Clarke, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said George Story hath given granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell to the said William D. Clarke five hundred pounds of bacon, five barrels corn and one thousand pounds black
