Tiller his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said Robert Rowland, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; doth grant, bargain sell and deliver unto the said Robert Rowland one certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid, containing one hundred and sixty seven acres, to the same more or less, but one acre around the grave yard is excepted for a burying place, bounded by the lands of John S. Waller, William H. Godwyn, and Matthew Parkes estate, and also the various divisions, remainders & covenants of profits there of together, with all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever unto the said Robert Rowland his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Robert Rowland, his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John W. Tiller and Christian L. Tiller his wife, the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Robert Rowland and his heirs, and against all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend by their premises; In witness whereof the said John W.
