Moore his heirs and assigns forever, & to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Moore his heirs & assigns forever, and they the said Uniah Pauls give for themselves, their heirs executors & administrators do by their presents, warrant & forever defend, the said bargain'd premises, against the claims or claims of them the said Uniah Pauls give & of all and every person whatsoever.
