This Indenture made and entered into this 27th day of April
one thousand eight hundred and forty three between William Wallopy of the
first part James & Peter of the second part and Ed James R. Anderson Mires and
DR. Newson of the third part Witnesseth that the said Wallopy is indebted to Ed James
R. Anderson Mires in the sum of two thousand dollars due on judgment and another debt due by bond
to Anderson Mires in the sum of three hundred dollars, and another bond due to DR. Newson
in the sum of two hundred dollars and the said Wallopy being willing and desirous to
secure the said auditors. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James & Peter to the said
William Wallopy at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged by the said Wallopy hath granted bargained and sold and
by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James & Peter his heirs and
assigns forever the following property to wit. house hold and kitchen furniture stock
of goods 6 horses 2 yoke of new 1/4 head of cattle one buggy one cart 17 head of sheep
55 sheep all debts due me by bond or open account all my growing crop of corn &
of dds cotton & bacon. To have and to hold all the above named property with all
the right title and interest which he the said Wallopy has in or to the above named
property to him the said James & Peter his heirs and assigns forever. Upon trust
Nevertheless that he the said James & Peter at the request of either of the parties
adventurer the above named property at three or more public sales within this County by
giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale shall proceed to sell to the highest
bidder for cash the above named property or as much as may be sufficient to pay
and satisfy the above named debts with all cost and interest accruing on the same as
well as all cost attending this trust and in case a surplus should remain in the hands
of the said James & Peter after paying the aforesaid debts interest and cost the same
shall be paid over to the said Wallopy his heirs or assigns &c in case the above debts
shall be paid it shall be the duty of the said James & Peter to release the property
