This Indenture made this 3rd day of May 1843. between William T Bryant and
 Matilda his wife of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part and
 Denis Bryant of the said County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said
 William T Bryant and Matilda his wife for and consideration of the sum of one
 hundred and forty four dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof whereby aforesaid
 witness hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and do by these presents
 grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Denis Bryant his heirs & assigns
 forever one certain piece lot and parcel of land lying and being in the County of
 Southampton & State of Virginia and bounded as follows. Beginning at the center
 of a poplar maple black gum standing in a small branch a new corner of said
 Denis Bryant in said William T Bryant's line thence down the run of said branch to
 Channels line thence Channels line down said branch to Joseph Gray's line thence his
 line down said branch to a maple a corner in Henry Hindman's line at fork of branches
 thence along said Hindman's line of marked trees nearly west course prong of branch to
 a pine standing near the head of the branch a new corner for said William T Bryant
 thence a new line of marked trees N. 15 E 1/4 pole to the beginning containing fifty
 acres it being same more or less. To have and to hold all and singular the said grants
 land and premises above mentioned unto the said Denis Bryant his heirs and assigns
 forever and the said William T Bryant and Matilda his wife for themselves their
 heirs & debts further agree to and with the said Denis Bryant his heirs & that they will
 forever warrant and defend the right title & interest of said premises before mentioned unto
 him the said Denis Bryant his heirs & assigns forever against the claim & demands of
 them the said William T Bryant & Matilda his wife their heirs and assigns forever or
