This Indenture made and entered into May the 15th 1843, between Jacob Bryant of the one part and Harrison Joyner of the second and Mary A. Daugherty of the third part. Whereas the said Jacob Bryant is indebted to the said Mary A. Daugherty in the sum of fifty five dollars & 25¢, due by note under seal for and bearing date the 15th of May 1843, which debt with the interest which may thereon accrue the said Jacob Bryant is desirous of securing now the indenture importeth that for & in consideration of one dollar to the said Jacob Bryant in hand paid by the said Harrison Joyner to the said Jacob Bryant hath bargained and sold by these presents doth bargain sell unto him the said Harrison Joyner the following property to wit a certain tract of land containing thirty eight acres & bounded by James Bryant & Jonathan B. Joyner to hold the aforesaid property unto them the said Harrison Joyner and his heirs forever. In trust of confidence nevertheless the said Harrison Joyner will permit the said Jacob Bryant retain possession of said property until a failure to pay the above mentioned debt and then upon the further trust that when the said Harrison Joyner will sell the aforesaid property under lawful limits to satisfy the aforesaid debt due to the said Mary A. Daugherty or cash having given at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale and after the payment of said debt and expenses of this trust return to the said Jacob Bryant any balance that may be remaining given under our hands and seals this day & date before mentioned.
