Now this Indenture witnesseth, that for the considerations aforesaid, as well as for the further consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars in hand paid, by the said Allen Edwards to the said Copeland Turner at and before the making and delivery of these presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) he the said Copeland Turner hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns, 160 acres of land aforesaid that is to say, all the estate, right, title interest, claim and demands both at law and equity, which the said Copeland Turner has or holds in the 160 acre land herein described. To have And To hold the said 160 acres of land to the said Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns forever, to the proper use and behoof of him the said Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Copeland Turner for himself and his heirs executors and administrators, the above mentioned 160 acres of land unto the said Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns, in as full and ample manner as was warranted by the said David Lewis by the deed of trust herein recited, do warrant the same to the said Allen Edwards against the claim or claims of him the said Copeland Turner and all persons claiming by or under him. I Schell for the sum of three hundred and forty six dollars all of the above bonds & sums the said George B Holliman is the said Thomas M Bailey's security, and the said T. M Bailey wishing to secure the said George B Holliman from harm in consequence of said securityships did by indenture of trust of that date convey to the said John Brown his heirs executors &c. the land and plantation belonging to the said Thomas M Bailey containing eleven hundred and eighty one acres be the same more
