And whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust the said Phineas M^r Bailey hath fully satisfied and paid to the said W^m R. Holliman, Gray Barrel and James B Clayton the several sums of money thereby secured which the said George B Holliman doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture witnesseth, that for and in consideration aforesaid, as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Phineas M^r Bailey to the said Joseph P^rttlow, at and before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Joseph P^rttlow with the assent and approbation of the said George B Holliman, signified by his being party to these presents, and the said George B Holliman have granted, bargained and sold, remised, released and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain & sell remain release and confirm unto the said Phineas M^r Bailey all the estate, right, title interest claim and demand, both at law and in equity, which the said Joseph P^rttlow & George B Holliman have, or hold in the land above described. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, to the said Phineas M^r Bailey, his heirs, executors & assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said P^r M^r Bailey, his heirs, executors, admors & assigns forever. And the said Joseph P^rttlow and George B Holliman for themselves, their heirs, executors & assigns, do above mentioned land, unto the said P^r M^r Bailey his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, in as full and ample manner as the same was warranted by the said Phineas M^r Bailey by the deed of trust above recited, do warrant the same to the said P^r M^r Bailey against the claim or claims of them the said Joseph P^rttlow and George B Holliman and all persons claiming by or under them or either of them.
