Deed No. 22087 made and entered into this 17<sup>th</sup> day of February in the  
year of our Lord 1842 between William D Phillips and his wife Rebecca D Phillips of  
the one part and William A Rochelle of the other part, all of the County of South-  
ampton County and State of Virginia (Witnesseth) That the said William D Phillips  
and his wife Rebecca D for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hun-  
dred dollars and — cents good and lawful money to them in hand paid at  
and before the executing and delivery of these presents, of the said Wm A Rochelle the  
receipt whereof or hereby acknowledged, hath given granted bargained sold and  
conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell and convey unto  
the said William A Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever, tract or parcel of  
land lying and being in the County of Southampton immediately on the Tanners  
Branch, containing seven hundred & forty two acres by former survey by the same  
owner or less, and bounded as follows (viz) by the said Creek on the east, George B  
Carey Esq on the S<sup>e</sup>, on the west by the road leading to Cynthian Bridge, being the  
line between said land & plantation Williams, & a son of Edward Beaton  
and on the north by Cream 13 myrt together with all of the improvements attached  
to said land, or in any way belonging. And the said William D Phillips and  
his wife Rebecca D doth by these presents covenant and agree to and with the the  
said Wm A Rochelle that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend the  
right and title of the aforesaid land and improvements of every description at-  
tached to the land hereby by sold or intended to be sold by these presents, unto  
him the said Wm A Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever and for their and each  
of their heirs and every person claiming by or through them, and all and every other  
person or persons whomsoever, they the said Wm D Phillips and wife doth hereby  
warrant the title of the aforesaid land and improvements aforesaid to the bounds  
for hereby surveyed unto him the said William A Rochelle and his heirs forever.
