This Deed of bargain and sale made and entered into this 31st day of May one thousand eight
hundred and forty three between Edwards Butts Arthur A Drury John Vick & Polly his
wife and Amos Drury of the County of Southampton of the one part and William J Hobell
of the same County of the other part. Whereas by an Indenture dated the 18th day of March 1842
and admitted to Record in the Clerk's Office of the County aforesaid on the 6th day of April 1843.
John Vick and Amos Drury for the purpose of securing Arthur A Drury their security to
certain forthcoming or delivery bonds mentioned and described in the said indenture did convey
unto Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns besides other property the following to wit. One water
grist Mill with the land attached thereto supposed to contain one hundred and thirty acres
lying on Casance swamp near above Simmons Church formerly stood, with all the appurten-
ances thereto belonging. In trust and with power and authority to the said Edwards Butts
at the request of the said Arthur A Drury his executors or administrators at any time after
judgments should be rendered on any or all of the said forthcoming or delivery bonds to
advertise and sell to the highest bidder for cash in the town of Jerusalem the property
conveyed by the said indenture for the sumpon of paying the said described debt with all
costs &c And whereas judgments having been rendered on the said forthcoming or delivery
bonds to which the said Arthur A Drury was the said John Vick & Amos Drury debtor
and the said Edwards Butts being requested by the said Arthur A Drury to make sale
of the property conveyed by the indenture aforesaid in the said Edwards Butts, having given
thirty days notice of the time, place and terms of sale by advertisements stuck up at
least three public places in the County aforesaid, did on the day (the 31st day of May
1843) by consent of the said John Vick, Amos Drury and Arthur A Drury signified
by their becoming parties to and signing this indenture set up and sell on the premises
at public auction to the highest bidder for cash the water grist Mill and lands
