This Indenture made the first day of December in the year 1842
between Thomas Doyle & Martha his wife & Mary Ann Brock of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Brule of the same County and State of the other part testifies that the said Thomas Doyle & Martha his wife & Mary Ann Brock in consideration of twenty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Brule at or before the making of delivery of this present have bargained & sold & by these presents do give and convey & sell unto the said Thomas Brule all their right and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land lying & bounded as follows commencing at a corner tree in the lower branch, a small bay tree a hickory tree and Cuckoo tree to a corner, thence a line of marked trees to a corner post oak between James Drake, from the post oak down a branch to a corner in Samm Drakes line, thence a line of marked trees to the lower branch, up said branch to the log in stock corner there being land containing 376 acres to the same more or less.
To have and to hold all this right of interest in the said tract or parcel of land with the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, with every of their rights unto the said Thomas Brule his heirs & assigns forever.
