RECEIVED by an Indenture bearing date on the 20th day of July 1862 between Editha R Edwards of the first part and William Booth of the other part and which was admitted to Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County on the 17th day of August 1863 the said William Booth became & is now entitled to all right title claim demand and intent whatever either at law or equity that Henry Booth had or shall have over and under in the estate of Peter Booth late of the County of Southampton in the hands of Editha R Edwards administrator of Peter Booth or in the hands of any other person or representative of the said Peter Booth as well as all the intent of the said Henry Booth in the slaves of Peter Booth estate whether being his intent in one third of the slaves of the estate of Peter Booth in remission or otherwise after the first day of January 1865 and also all the said Henry Booth right title claim intent of demand of what nature & kind there is or may be whether in law or equity in the estate of John Booth father of the said Henry Booth And whereas the said William Booth both agreed to give his services and money unto Editha R Edwards of the County of Southampton for the
