B. became & is now entitled to all right title claim demand and interest in the plantation situate at law or equity about Henry North he & also fully or in remainder in the estate of Peter North late of the County of Southampton in the hands of Edmunds Wells- estate of Peter North or in the hands of any other person or representative of the administrator of Peter North as well as all the interest of the said Henry North in the slaves of said Peter North estate whether being his interest in one third of the slaves of the estate of Peter North in remainder or otherwise after the first day of January 1802 and also all the said Henry North might title claim interest & demand of what nature or kind he may be whether in Law or equity in the estate of Peter North father of the said Henry North. And whereas the said William B. B. hath agreed to assign the same and convey unto Edmunds Wells of the County of Southampton for the
