Broth whether in the hands of Edward Butts administrator de bonis non with the will annexed of the said Pet. Broth, or in the hands of any other person or representative of the said Pet. Broth, and also all the right, title, claim and demand whatsoever which he the said William Beale has or may hereafter have, either at law or in equity, in regard to any monies which are now due, or which at any time hereafter may be due & owing, or to which the estate of the said John Broth (as matter in what character) or his representatives, heirs, or distributees, or those claiming under him are or may be entitled to receive from the estate of Pet.
