our seals and dated this 17th day of July A.D. 1843. — The Condition of
the above obligation is such that unless the above named Warren Edwards
has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as
Constable within the said County for the term of two years from the date hereof
Moss of the said Warren Edwards shall well and truly discharge
the duty of the Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance
therein then the above obligation to be void and to remain in full force &
virtue.

to pay and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto him the said John C.
Turner his heirs or assigns all my interest in the slaves belonging to the Estate of
Edwin Rice if he die in the possession of his widow Rebecca Rice under the last
will and testament of him the said Edwin Rice to her. also all my interest in the
furnished estate of all kinds at the death of her the said Rebecca Rice then in
as apiece of Edwin Rice or at any division of the estate that may occur
prior to the death of her the said Rebecca Rice which consists in the aforesaid
property I derived from the lawful marriage with the daughter of the said Edwin
Rice for her which will more fully appear by the will of him the said Edwin
Rice to her. The title to the same I sever warrant and defend against the claim
or demand of any person or persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof I do here
