our seals (and dated this 17th day of July, A.D. 1843. — The Condition of
this above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Harmon Edwards
has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as
Constable within the said County for the term of two years from the date hereof
Word of the said Harmon Edwards shall well and truly discharge
the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance
therein then the above obligation to be void unless to remain in full force &
virtue.

Turner his heirs or assigns all my interest in the slaves belonging to the Estate of
Edwin Reese Jr. deceased in the possession of his widow Rebecca Reese under the last
Will and testament of him the said Edwin Reese to wit: all my interest in the
probable Estate of all kinds, at the death of her the said Rebecca Reese widow
as executrix of Edwin Reese or at any division of the Estate that may occur
previous to the death of her the said Rebecca Reese which interest in the above
property I derived from the lawful marriage with the daughter of the said Ed-
win Reese Jr. deceased which will more fully show by the will of him the said Ed-
win Reese Jr. deceased. The title to the same I gave warrant and defend against the claim
or demand of any person or persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof I do here
