This Indenture, made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of Christ One Thousand  
Eight hundred and forty three, between Miles Pope of the first part, Edwin D. Nash of  
the second part; and Richard Darden of the third part, whereas the said Miles Pope  
is justly indebted unto the said Richard Darden in the sum of three hundred  
and twelve dollars and ninety nine cents due by bond of this date and on demand. And  
wheras the said Miles Pope is desirous to have, and hath agreed to have the payment  
of the said debt and interest, with all charges attending the same in accordance  
with the terms by which the said party hereinbefore mentioned unto the said Edwin D.  
Nash, \$1000 worth, therefore This Indenture witnesseth, that the said Miles Pope is  
in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to him by the said Darden in  
hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, shall have and hold the said  
enfeoffed, dispossess and make over, and doth by these presents, forgive and release  
all former debts and moneys owing to the said Edwin D. Nash his heirs executors  
and administrators, one certain tract of land lying and being in the County of  
Southampton containing two hundred and fifty six and three fourth acre more  
or less, adjoining Nathan Pope, John Mathews, the said Richard Darden  
being the same owner of the said Richard Darden over and under, to have and to hold the aforesaid  
mentioned land and improvements thereon above mentioned unto the said Edwin  
D. Nash his heirs executors administrators & assigns an term of open condition nevertheless  
that the said Miles Pope shall retain possession of the said granted land and premises  
until the said Edwin D. Nash shall be requested by the said Richard Darden to sell  
the same, and then the said Nash after giving reasonable public notice of the time  
and place of sale, sell for lack of a higher bidder, on the premises above
