This Indenture made and entered into the 17th day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty three between William Soyars and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of St. Mary of the one part and Harrison Beale of the same County and parish of the other part witnesses that the said William Soyars and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollar current money to them in hand paid by the said Harrison Beale the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bought sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Harrison Beale and his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation twenty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a red oak a corner line in John Soyars line thence Soyars line thence along John Soyars line to a good old corner line in said Soyars line thence along D. Soyars line to a large pine in D. Soyars line and Harrison Beale line thence along a branch in Beale line to a small pine a corner line in D. Beale line and James Jeynes line thence a straight line to the oak the first landmark together with all houses out houses edifices buildings gardens orchards ways water and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any way appertaining to the D. Beale or parcel of land and premises. To have and to hold the same unto the D. Harrison Beale his heirs and his heirs forever and the D. Beale Soyars and Mary his wife doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Harrison Beale his heirs and assigns that they will warrant & forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or portion thereof for ever unless released the said William Soyars and Mary his wife hath executed at their hands & affixed their seals the day and date first above written.
