I the said James J Williams, hath given granted bargained and sold unto him the said William P Moore the following property to wch Viz One hundred and six acres of Land it being the tract or which I the said James J Williams in 1838 pay 149 now lie bounded by the lands of James Scott lately deceased lying in the side of the road leading west to Jerusalem two five miles or there about distant, on horseback and bridle (a grey filly) Four beds, stock and furniture, twenty head of sheep, fifteen head of cattle, five head of sheep, all my sorts of corn for seed & grain growing in the said County of Southampton & State of Virginia, two clocks, Buffet, glasses, one dozen chairs together with all and singular my household and kitchen furniture, clothing and farming utensils & three carts, whale and gun, one single bullet and knife - and also all my stock of goods now in hand, with the privilege of selling and buying so that I keep the stock agreed at now is, all my stocks hands and servants together with all and singular my other property in the said County of Southampton and State of Virginia not specially named in this instrument. To have and to hold unto him the said William P Moore and his heirs forever. Whereas I further - own myself that the said James J Williams is to remain in quiet possession of all the aforesaid property & until agreed by the said Abram Riddick to be sold whereupon the said William P Moore shall after advertising for ten days, proceed to sell for Cash or otherwise as agreed on all the property of the said James J Williams and first paying the expense of sale & then pay to the said Abram Riddick the sum of six hundred and ten dollars & fees with lawful interest from July 8th 1843 and the balance in the hands of the said Moore he shall pay over to the said James J Williams.
