Nash his heirs executors & administrators that the said C Wright Briggs shall retain before of the said bargaining slaves until default of payment shall be made unto the said C Wright shall be required by the said George A H Neuman his heirs executors & administrators to make sale thereof, and the said Nash or his executors augmented as aforesaid shall have to sell at public auction to the highest bidder for the above granted slaves giving reasonable profit thereon and from the proceeds of such sale first paying all reasonable charge attending the said sale, secondly pay and satisfy the debts, interest due to the said George A H Neuman or executors of said debt as may be due, and the surplus of any price to the said Ethelred E Briggs his heirs executors & administrators. And the said Ethelred E Briggs covenant with the said C Wright Nash that he will forever warrant and defend the title to said slaves unto him and Nash his heirs & In Testimony whereof the said Ethelred E Briggs and the said C Wright Nash have hereunto set their hands sealed the 25th day of July 1812

This Indenture made the 15th day July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty three between Silas Vick of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Brante of the County of Southampton of the other part Whitefield that for and in consideration of the just sum of one hundred and fifty dollars of which Thomas Brante is bound paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents he receipt whereof the said Silas Vick hereby acknowledges and thereby agrees and for ever discharges the said Thomas Brante his heirs and assigns forever and by this present the said Silas Vick hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed unto the said present with grant bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Brante one acre more or less of land situated to me in the County of Southampton after enclosed arranged by a post in land containing one acre of land of Vick's with all the premises orchards houses & gardens and all my rights in said land lying along in a narrow County of St Lukes parish to have the same to Thomas Brante to have to lease & to have of the said Silas Vick fully by these presents warranted & defend all right titles therein or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same as my part or general thereof. In witness whereof I the said Silas Vick hath hereunto set my hand & seal. I also do hereby sell & deliver to and unto Thomas all my house hold property (to wth) a walnut bpt & the chest one box both stone glass stone glass bound iron pot & slate fire tools & a large gourd with what else
