Granville Spruntley & *William* *John P. Parker* of the third part. The said *Senne*
being indebted to the said *Parker* in the sum of about one hundred and fifty dollars
due by bond &c. &c. of _____ day of _____ 1832 and to the said *Charles* in the sum
of two hundred dollars due by open account and to the said *Lawrence* & *Wofflet* in the
sum of \$327. *Abraham* sum of eighty five dollars *John Hurley* sum of twenty two dollars *Isaac*
Robinson sum of twenty seven dollars *James Olney* sum of ten dollars *Edmund Pauls* sum
