third part Charles W. Wofflet Abram Riddick John Early Samuel Robinson James  
Edgar Edward Pauls Thomas Lawrence Allen & Robinson Richard H. Beaman Nelson  
B. Gardner Joseph B. Johnson Hardy Long Robert Childy John A. Williams Edward  
Crampler Spratley & Williams John F. Parker of the third part. The said Senow  
being indebted to the said Parker in the sum of about one hundred and fifty dollars  
due by bond dated \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 1822 and to the said Charles W. Wofflet in the sum  
of two hundred dollars due by open account and to the said James Robinson in the  
sum of \$27. Above sum of eighty five dollars John Early sum of twenty two dollars Lewis  
Robinson sum of twenty seven dollars James Edgar sum of ten dollars Edward Pauls sum  
of seven dollars Thomas Lawrence sum of two dollars Allen Robinson sum of fifty nine doll-  
ars & forty cents and Richard H. Beaman sum eighteen dollars Nelson B. Gardner

much a suit is now depending in the Circuit Superior Court of Chancery for the County of South-  
ampton by way of fringed attachment to have possession and assigns thereof Upon  
suit movably that the said Robinson shall collect the said money before aforesaid  
to and out of the same first pay the debt and interest due to said Parker and  
whenever and then pay the other debts hereby secured and all interest which may  
be due on the same, and the balance of any, pay over to the said Senow his heirs or  
assigns. But if the said debt shall be fully paid before the said money is collected  
by the said Senow, then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force.
