This Indenture made the 25th day of July in the year of our Lord 1842
between Thomas J. Batten and Clara Batten his wife of the County of Southampton
of the one part, David Jane A. Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret C. Julia D. Julia E.
Joshua, Jordan D. and Samuel B. Batten of the said County of the other part, Witness
that whereas Thomas Batten late of the County of Southampton departed this life on the
21st day of June 1840 after having first executed his last will and Testament and
wherein said having expressed as to the disposition of that trust after estate (real) should
to his wife, being the plantation wherein the said Thomas Batten resided at the time of
his death, now therefore in order to secure an equal and just distribution of the estate
of the said Thomas Batten among all his children as well as for the sum of one dollar
lawful money of the U. States to them the said Thomas Batten and his wife, a
bond given by the said Jane A. Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret C. Julia D. Julia E.
Joshua, Jordan D. and Samuel B. Batten at or before the making and delivery of this
present the said wife of is hereby acknowledged. The said Thomas Batten and Clara
at his wife both given grant of said and confirmed and by their personal self give
sell and assign unto the said Jane A. Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret C. Julia D. Julia E.
Joshua, Jordan D. and Samuel B. Batten their heirs and assigns first
all the right interest and title in possession, reversion or remainder which they do hold
Thomas J. Batten and Clara at his wife has or may have in the land wherein the
Thomas Batten resided at the time of his death together with the appurtenances
therein belonging or appertaining. To have and to hold the said heirs and assigns of the
all interest right and title as aforesaid with its appurtenances to the said Jane A.
Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret C. Julia D. Julia E. Joshua, Jordan D. and Samuel
B. Batten, their heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of them the said
Jane A. Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret C. Julia D. Julia E. Joshua, Jordan D.
and Samuel B. Batten and of their heirs and assigns forever. And the said Thomas
J. Batten and Clara at his wife for themselves and their heirs with consent, permission
and agree to and with the said Jane A. Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret C. Julia D. Julia E.
Joshua, Jordan D. and Samuel B. Batten their heirs and assigns that they
the said Thomas J. Batten and Clara at his wife and their heirs do stand first as
general of record of record made then the said Jane A. Anne, Mary Batten, Margaret
C. Julia D. Julia E. Joshua, Jordan D. and Samuel B. Batten their heirs and
assigns against the claims of the said Thomas J. Batten and Clara at his wife
their heirs and all their persons whatsoever claiming under or through them and
will by this present covenant and power defend. In witness whereof they have
