This Indenture made the 13^d day of January Aforethanked, Eight hundred and forty three between Joseph Buxton and Nancy his wife of the one part, and Remondy Tallow of the other part all of the County of Guilford and State of Virginia; Witnesseth that the said Joseph Buxton & Nancy his wife for the consideration of the sum of Thirty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Remondy Tallow, at & before his sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargain and sold and do hereby present do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Remondy Tallow his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid lot of Southampton and bounded as follows. Beginning at a Spruce pine corner of S^d M. Gardner and the said Joseph Buxton and from thence to another Spruce pine corner of Gordon and S^d Thum. from thence along the said line to a gum in the swamp, thence a new line of marked trees along the said swamp to a gum side line of the S^d Joseph Buxton and Grenville Gardner, and from thence to the beginning. Containing ten acres more or less, together with all, waste meadows, pastures, meadows and remainder, gently and other lands, trees and profits thereof and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements and householdings and all and singular other the premises herein contained to be bought and sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their right members appertaining unto the said Remondy Tallow his heirs and assigns forever and to the said Joseph Buxton and Nancy his wife for themselves and their heirs the tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises appertaining to by the receipt unto the said Remondy Tallow his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Joseph Buxton and Nancy his wife, whether of them the said or either of their heirs and of all and every person persons whatsoever, shall well and lawfully and forever defend by their presents.
