This 2^d September made this 8th day of August eighteen hundred & forty three, between John Drury of the first part, Hartwell Estate of the second part & Saml Drury of the third part. Whereas the said Hartwell Estate doth hold of me, the said John Drury, Eighteen hundred & forty two, in order to secure the payment of the sum of four hundred & fifty two dollars & ninety six, to the said Saml Drury, did by me, Surety of trust of that date, convey to the said, Mr. Drury, his heirs executors & administrators of the following property to wit, I trust or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton, containing one hundred & twenty seven acres to the same river up and bounded by the lands of Ward Prince, Lewis Romeo & the land belonging to the estate of The Applewhite Esq^r and to oppose more fully, it being the land which the said Toto now holds, also one acre more named Seven acre in a meadow named Green, also two holes and another house held of Nathan Farmer which the said Toto has now in occupation, also two houses some land of cattle, trees, fence, brush, corn, straw and several black folds of timber, head of logs, and several other land cases of corn & fodder to consume, then to much as the said Estate has or holds of whom he has at the time the trust is retained with all and singular the appurtenances the said trust of land, belonging or in any wise appertain to and at the estate of title & intent of the said Estate in the said tract of land, one acre reserved to the property before named, which is hereby expressly noted, the said John Drury has his wherein &c And whereas, upon the executing and delivery of the said deed of trust, said Hartwell Estate hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Saml Drury the sum of money thereby received, which the said Saml Drury hath fully acknowledged. Now the subscriber witnesseth that for the consideration of sixteen as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Hartwell Estate to the said Saml Drury at and before the sealing and delivery of the premises, the receipt whereof is herby acknowledged by the said Saml Drury with the agent and approbation of the said Saml Drury signified by his being party to this present and the said Saml Drury has granted bargained and sold remised released and confirmed, and by the present do grant bargain and sell, remaind release and confirm unto said Hartwell Estate all the estate, right, title, interest, claim & demand both at law & in equity, which the said John Drury has or holds in the land of negroes, together property above mentioned, to have and to hold the said tract of land together with the aforesaid negroes, property, their heirs the executing and delivering of said deed of trust to the said Hartwell Estate to his executors administrators of forever to the only person and behoef of him to said Hartwell Estate his heirs executors administrators of forever, and the said Saml Drury & Saml Drury for themselves their heirs & assigns for the above named land negroes & other property unto the said Hartwell Estate his executors administrators of in as full and ample manner as the same was executed by the said Hartwell Estate by the said deed above recited, so warrant the same to the said Toto against the claim or claims of whom the said John Drury & Saml Drury and all persons by or with them or either of them.
