This Indenture made the — day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three between John Sory of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and James D. Westbrooke of the said County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said John Sory for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars in hand paid by the said Jas D. Westbrooke the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Jas D. Westbrooke his heirs and assigns his interest in the tract of land now held by the said John Sory as Receiver in right of his wife Sory formerly Westbrooke it being the said which Sall Westbrooke said he got and possessed containing by estimation three hundred and seventy four to the same more or less which being the said John Sory's right lying and being in the County aforesaid and on the south side of three creeks and bounded as follows by the lands of Humphrey Dancy John Dancy and Simon J. Westbrooke. To have & to hold all the interest belonging to the said John Sory or in anywise appertaining unto him the said James D. Westbrooke his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jas D. Westbrooke his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John Sory doth for himself his heirs and assigns warrant and give before his right hand and unto the said Jas D. Westbrooke his heirs and assigns a confirmation or assign forever against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons.
