other part. Witnesseth that the said John Drury for and in consideration of the sum
of three hundred dollars in hand paid by the said Jas D. Westcott the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do
bargain and sell unto the said Jas D. Westcott his heirs and assigns his interest in
the tract of land now held by the said John Drury as Power in right of his wife Mary
Drury formerly Westcott it being the said which Jas D. Westcott did buy and
possess containing by estimation three hundred and seventy four acres the same more
or less which being the said John Drury's right, lying and being in the County aforesaid
situated on the south side of the creek and bounded as follows by the lands of
Aumphrey Drury John Drury and Simon D. Westcott. To have & to hold all
the interest belonging to the said John Drury or in anywise appertaining unto him
the said James D. Westcott his heirs and assigns forever to the only purpose before
of him the said Jas D. Westcott his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John
Drury doth for himself his heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend his right in
and lands unto the said Jas D. Westcott his heirs executors administrators & assigns
forever against the right title claim or interest of all and every other person or persons.

by the said Albert G. Price also before the recording and sealing of these presents, they
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do
and each of them, with bargain and sell unto the said Albert G. Price his heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty six
acres more or less adjoining the land of Sam'l Harris Daniel Drury, and the heirs of
