This Indenture made the 28th of July 1803, between Edwin Daughtrey & Sonnena Berggins his wife of the one part and Thurn Berggins of the other part, witnesseth that the said Edwin Daughtrey and wife in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty dollars paid by the said Thurn Berggins at or before the sealing and delivering of this present the eighteenth day of July acknowledged above bargained and sold and doth then present bargain and sell unto the said Thurn Berggins his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation 100 acres in the same more or less lying in County of Southampton State of Va. and bounded as follows, to wit on the East by the Cameron land on the Brook by the Bull land on the west by Edwin Parker land three down the road on Edwin Daughtrey land to the common road together with all the buildings thereon and the appurtenances whatsoever to the said Thurn Berggins to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances before mentioned and to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every member and appurtenance unto the said Thurn Berggins his heirs and assigns free to use and for the only purpose and behoef of him the said T. Berggins his heirs assigns, forever, and the said Edwin Daughtrey acknowledge and this his the tract or parcel of land with all and singular appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Thurn Berggins his heirs and assigns, forever free from the claims or claims of the said Edwin Daughtrey and wife and their heirs and of all and of every person whatsoever shall well and we warrant and forever defend by these presents.
