This Indenture made the 28th of July 1822 between Edwin Daughtery & Tompkins his wife of the one part and Thos Perry of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edwin Daughtery and wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred & thirty five pounds to them paid by the said Thos Perry at or before the making and delivering of this present the right whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Thos Perry his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation 100 acres be the same more or less lying in County of Southampton Part of 1st and bounded as follows, to wit on the East by the Lamington lands on the South by the Brits land on the west by Edwin Parker land Thence down the road an Edwin Daughtery land to the common road together with all the building tenement and other appurtenances, whosoever to the said Thos Perry. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Thos Perry his heirs and assigns forever with every part and parcel thereof with every of the appurtenances and appurtenances unto the said Thos Perry his heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said T. Perry his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Edwin Daughtery and wife and their heirs this tract or parcel of land with all and singular appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Thos Perry his heirs and assigns forever free from the claims or claims of the said Edwin Daughtery and wife and their heirs and of all and of every person from whatsoever shall well and do warrant and save defend by their persons.
