Forty acres be the same more or less, and bounded as follows To wit Beginning
at a small pine a corner Baby Jones and John Camp thence on that line
63 pole to a Walnut tree standing in front of the house, thence 49 pole to the head
of a small gravelly brook thence up the various courses of the said river to the upper
extremity of the gravelly run and the little dam branch, thence up the various
courses of the little dam branch to a black gum standing on the edge of a branch
a C of Seminick Jones and Ely Jones and in John Camps present line
thence along above of marked tree between Seminick Jones and John Camp
53 pole to the first station. Together with all houses, out houses, edifices buildings
yards of gardens, orchards, ways, water, and water courses, whatsoever belonging or in
anywise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land and premises. To have
and to hold the same unto the D. John Camp to him and to his heirs forever
and the said Baby Jones and Nancy his wife for themselves, their heirs, exec-
utors & administrators etc by these presents grant, to and unto the D. John Camp,
his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and defend all right, title
claim or demand of any person claiming or demanding the same or any part

This Indenture made and entered into the 2^d day of May in the year of our
Lord 1840. Between Odwin & Hart and Sally his wife of the first part and Seth
D. Williams of the other part act of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
witnesseth that for and in consideration of the summes and also for the further con-
sideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to the said Hart and wife we have
paid by the said Seth D. Williams at or before the making and delivery of these
presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given granted bargained
and sold, and by these presents do give grant Bargain and sell unto the said
Seth D. Williams his heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of land
containing twenty seven and one half acre or less and bounded by the lands
of Sefra Tackett James & Rose and others. To have and to hold the said
land or parcel of land and premises with every of its appurtenances thereunto
belonging or in anywise appertaining unto him the said Seth D. Williams
