John Camps House; containing by estimation Forty acres be the same more or less, and bounded as follows To wit; Beginning at a small pine a corner Caly Jorner and John Camp thence westward to a pole to a Walnut tree standing in front of the house, thence N 90° E to the house call'd; thence Run thence up the various courses of the D. run to the intersection of the generally run and the little dam branch, thence up the various courses of the little dam branch to a black gum standing in the edge of a branch a c. of Summah Jorner and Caly Jorner and in John Camps present time thence along a line of marked trees between Summah Jorner and John Camp to a pole to the first Station Together with all houses, out houses, self-rais building yards, of arable, or chards, meads, waters, and water courses, what ever belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land and premises. To have and to hold the same unto the D. John Camp to him and to his heirs forever and the said Caly Jorner and Nancy his wife for themselves, their heirs, executors & administrators doth by their parents grant, to and unto the D.
