consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to each of them in hand paid by the said

aforesaid acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents doth and hereby
doth individually bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and
affees all the right title interest and estate which they and each of them make
or may ever hereafter have, to a certain portion of land herein described in writing
or conditionally as the legitimate children of John Rennell R. above named or
certain portion of land by his father Melody Rennell by his last will and testament for
and during the natural life of his son the said John Rennell which portion of land is now in the said
Clerk's Office for the said County of Southampton which portion of land is now in the pos-
session of the said John Rennell in the said County of Southampton. To have and to
