To have and to hold the said Mill, Mill race and privileges to him, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said George Randall in return his wife for the same then his heirs and assigns do covenant and warrant to the said Isaac Randall his heirs and assigns, to peace warrant and defend against true and perfect title to the above granted mill land and privilege free from the claims and demands of themselves their heirs & assigns, and from the claims and demands of all other persons. In testimony, whereof the said Randall & wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and date first above written.
