This Indenture, made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August one thousand eight hundred and forty three between Seth Charles of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Eli Bracke of the other part, witness that the said Seth Charles, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Eli Bracke, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged himself fully satisfied and said land granted herein and sold. One certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Russell containing by estimation sixteen acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a October tree on Seth Charles land, thence a straight line of marked trees to a pine tree in the said Charles line, thence a straight line of marked trees to Jane Bell's down land, thence a straight line of marked trees to the first station, together with all the houses and houses way water ways water areas orchard garden &c belonging in any way appertaining. To have and to hold the said land to him the said Eli Bracke to him and his heirs forever, and the said Seth Charles will warrant and defend from all these persons any person claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof.
