Scott & William S. Fox of the third part Whereas the said Thomas M. Newell is fully indebted to the said Edwin S. Scott the sum of Five hundred and ninety four dollars and ten cents due on three bonds bearing date, one on the 5th day of June 1842 for the sum of sixty three dollars & 25^{cts} one due on the 1st day of July 1843 for the sum of two hundred dollars, one do 1st day of Sept for the sum of thirty dollars & 64^{cts} one note due William S. Fox for the sum of three dollars due the 31st day of May 1842
