This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of August 1843 between William
Holt of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and J.B. Neuman of the
same County and State of the second part and Drury Waller of the said County and State
of the third part Witnesseth that the said William Holt in order to secure and provide for
the payment of a loan given by the said William Holt to the said Drury Waller for the
payment of two hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money of Virginia bearing date the
17 day of August 1843 also of the consideration of one dollar to the said Holt is hereby
bound by the said J.B. Neuman the receipt whereof is acknowledged that the said William
Holt has given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain
and sell unto the said J.B. Neuman his heirs and assigns forever all his right title and
interest to and in the following property to wit his certain outfit of certain Olden brand of trousers
together with 18 short & half size and pair of coat whole to have and to hold the same
to the said J.B. Neuman to him and his heirs forever subject nevertheless to the trust that
the said J.B. Neuman shall hold the foregoing property upon the full covenants to wit
that at any or provided of time the said Drury Waller being still due and unpaid that the said
Drury Waller shall direct the said J.B. Neuman to see that he shall do so by paying
to the highest bidder for cash or on such credit as the said Drury Waller may direct
all of the above property that is hereby secured after advertising the time and place of
sale for twenty days. Upon the further trust that the said J.B. Neuman shall in the first
instance pay out of the amounts all of sum of debt and clear pay over to the said Drury
Waller what appears to be due as principal and interest on said loan and the balance of
any pay over to the said William Holt upon further trust that the said William Holt
shall be permitted to retain the possession of the above named property until such time as a
sale thereof shall be made under the directions of the deed and the said J.B. Neuman on
his part is hereby covenant and agree faithfully to discharge the duties imposed upon him
in relation whereof no other second parties of the first second and third parties do hereby set on
hands and affix our seals this 17th day of August 1843.
