The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Thomas Batton adm'r of Ann Batton dec'd has this day paid to the said Alfred Ricks who is the legal guardian of John & Mary A Batton the said John and Mary having ten of the distribution of the said Ann Batton the sum of one thousand four hundred ninety three dollars and twenty four cents twelve hundred and ninety eight dollars and sixty two cents of which being the amount principal and interest up to this day which was derived to the question at law of John & Mary A Batton to be paid out of Sarah C Batton portion of the estate of Ann Batton dec'd the said Sarah C having been adjudged one of the distributees of the said Ann Batton dec'd by the County Court of Southampton and the other hundred ninety four dollars and sixty two cents being the balance in full principal and interest due the said John and Mary A Batton as distributees of Ann Batton dec'd as will appear by a reference to the Master Comptroller's report. Now therefore of the said Alfred Ricks guardian as of record shall refund the proportion of any debt or demands which may hereafter appear against the Estate of the said wife Ann Batton dec'd and the costs attending the recovery of such debt and demands then this obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force and obligation.
