Know all men by these presents that we Alfred Ricka Benjamin Berary of New Britain do in the just and full sum of three thousand dollars for the payment of which well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our heirs firmly by these presents to them under our hands and seals this the 19th of August eighteen hundred & forty three.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Thomas S Butler admin of Ann Butler do has this day paid to the said Alfred Ricka who is the legal guardian of John & Mary M Butler the said John and Mary M being two of the distributees of the said Ann Butler the sum of one thousand four hundred ninety three dollars and twenty four cents, twelve hundred ninety eight dollars and sixty two cents of which being the amount principal and interest up to this day which was due to the guardian at law of John & Mary M Butler he has paid out of Sarah C Butler portion of the estate of Ann Butler do the said Sarah C having been adjudged one of the distributees of the said Ann Butler do by the County Court of Southampton, and the other hundred ninety four dollars and sixty two cents being the balance in full principal and interest due the said John and Mary M Butler as distributees of Ann Butler do as will appear by a reference to the Master Comptroller's report. Now therefore if the said Alfred Ricka guardian as aforesaid shall refuse due proportion of any debt or demands which may hereafter appear against the estate of the aforesaid Ann Butler do and the costs attending the recovery of such debt and demands then this obligation is to be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force and obligation.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas Thomas S Butler who is the administrator of Ann Butler do has paid this day paid unto the above named Mary Butler who is by a decree of the County Court entitled to the sum of six hundred fifty eight dollars and fifty cents that being the amount principal and interest up to the day due to the said Mary Butler to be paid out of Sarah C Butler's portion of the estate of Ann Butler do the said Sarah C Butler do having been adjudged one of the distributees of the said Ann Butler do. Now therefore if the said Mary Butler as aforesaid shall refuse due proportion of any debt or demands which may hereafter appear against the estate of the aforesaid Ann Butler do and the costs attending the recovery of such debt and demands then this
