Gardner and Emily his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand by the said Mamma Edwards, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, bargain, sold and sold unto by the present bargain and sell, alienate, convey and confirm unto the said Mamma Edwards her heirs, and assigns forever, one certain tract and parcel of land containing one hundred and ninety three acres and a half more or less, lying and being in Southampton County, State of Va. and bounded by the lands of Jas. H. Marpley, Jas. Moore, James W. Edwards and the Wells Marple tract which well more fully appears by reference to the deed from the said Mamma Edwards to the said Geo. H. Gardner and Emily his wife of said tract and parcel of land, To have and to hold the above said tract and parcel of land forever unto the said Geo. H. Gardner and Emily his wife do hereby covenant and will forever defend the above said tract and parcel of land together with all the premises and accessories thereto and remainors greatly increased unto unto the said Mamma Edwards her heirs, and assigns forever from all the claims or claims demands or demands of all and every person whomsoever the testimony whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year as is aforementioned.
