Vigilant & Trustee in the County of Southampton State of Virginia, Whereas that the said Esrum Spring for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars, fifty cents which said sum is due to the said James B Vigilant from the said Esrum Spring by bond bearing date the 18th day of Sept 1803, as well as all other monies which may be due or owing from the said Esrum Spring to the said James B Vigilant by means of any dealing, transfer of debt, property whatever as also for and in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Richd Vigilant. The receipt whereof the said Esrum Spring, doth hereby acknowledge, he hath granted, bargained & sold, by these presents with heily grant, bargain & sell convey made over unto the said Richd A Vigilant his heirs forever all his right, title and interest in the plantation wherein he now resides, containing by estimation One hundred forty acres to the same more or less bounded by the ordinary bound on the north by the lands of William R Stephenson on the south, on the east by the lands of Rebecca Stephenson & on the west by the lands of William R Woods also a tract of land known as a portion of the Lanes tract containing by estimation one hundred four acres to the same more or less bounded by the lands of Elijah Lovell on the north, Ifpa Spring on the west, William Spring, and on the south & Ifpa Bailey on the east belonging to him the said Esrum Spring. To have & hold with all the right & estate of the said Esrum Spring having conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said Richd A Vigilant his heirs and of his assigns.
