H. Rawls of the first part and George A. M. Newman of the second part and Samuel B. Wright
of the third part whereas the said William H. Rawls is justly indebted to the said George
B. Wright in the sum of twenty five dollars due by bond bearing date the 1st day
February 1830 being for the rent of lot and house in Somerset. And whereas the said
William H. Rawls is desirous and hath agreed to secure the payment of the said debt
indent with all charges attending the same or in case of the failure of the premises
in the property herein after mentioned unto the said George A. M. Newman his law
admirer or assigns. In Trust now therefore. This Indenture witnesseth that the said
William H. Rawls in consideration of the premises and of the further consideration
one dollar to him by the said trustee in hand paid, the receipt whereof is here
acknowledged hath bargained and sold confirmed assigned granted sold and do by the
present bargain and sell confirm assign make and unto the said George A. M. Newman
the following property to wit: two beds and 1 bedstead of furniture one set of chairs one table
set of plates and dishes one set of cups and saucers one wash stand one bed and pitcher one
jug one rocking chair one looking glass a picture frame one cooking tub one set
