This Indenture made this 18th day of September AD 1852 by and between him H Rawls of the first part and George A.M. Newman of the second part and James B. Wright of the third part witnesseth that the said William H Rawls is justly indebted to the said Sam B. Wright in the sum of forty dollars due by him bearing date the 25th day February 1852 being for the rent of his land house in Somersham And whereas the said William H Rawls is desirous and hath agreed to have the payment of the said debt in part with all charges attending the same or interest by reason of the foregoing conveyance of the property herein after mentioned unto the said George A.M. Newman has been admitted & agreed. In Trust now therefore. This Indenture witnesseth that the said William H Rawls in consideration of the premises and of the further consideration one dollar to him by the said trustee in hand paid, the receipt whereof is here acknowledged, hath bargained and sold confirmed of good & valid and as is by the presents bargain and sell wherein appears more and unto the said George A.M. Newman the following property to wily the lands and heredoms of Somersham one set of slaves one table set of plates and dishes one set of cups and saucers one wash stand, two bowls and pitcher one teapot one rocking chair, one looking glass a picture frame, one writing table with a fayre one set of linens & cloths one carpet & set of glass ware two wine bottles & staves & bottle brush four candle sticks together with all the other house hold & kitchen furniture to have and to hold the aforesaid property unto the said George A.M. Newman his heirs assigns & affigees forever on trust upon condition nevertheless that the said Newman shall at the request of either of the parties aforesaid the above named premises & house or other public places in the County by giving ten days notice of the time and place shall present to all the parties aforesaid property to be disposed of for such uses and uses as shall be sufficient to satisfy the aforesaid debt and out of the proceeds funds in the first place to discharge all legal & usual costs attending the sale of the aforesaid property to pay of satisfy the debt herein first aforesaid to be due to the said William H. Wright with the remaining interest therein, and the surplus of any money over to the said William H Rawls his heirs assigns & affigees.
