This Indenture made and entered into the 20th day of February A.D. 1863
 between William R. Edwards of the County of Southampton of the first part
 and William J. Schell and Nicholas M. Schell of the said County of the
 other part Whereas Thomas C. Jones & James H. Schell by an Indenture bearing
 date the day of March 1839 and admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of the
 County aforesaid on the 25th day of April 1839 for the purpose of conveying
 and securing William J. Schell & Nicholas M. Schell against all and
 every loss or damage whatever in consequences of their having the said Thomas C.
 Jones and James H. Schell bound to certain lands in the said Indenture
 mentioned and described with Convey into the said William R. Edwards
 amongst other the following property to wit a certain piece or parcel of
 land lying east of Jerusalem and containing about thirty seven acres
 or less which said piece or parcel of land the said Thomas C. Jones and
 James H. Schell purchased of Henry B. Vaughan: Upon Trust and with
 power and authority to the said William R. Edwards upon being requested
 to do by the said William J. & N. M. Schell their said acknowledged or
 to make sale of the said property at public auction to the highest bidder for
 the purpose of paying the debt mentioned in the said Indenture for which
