Howell we had and formerly lived unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of five thousand dollars for the payment whereof well and truly to his Master we have made our last Execution and administration generally and diversly formerly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the 16th day of October 1843:

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Samuel T. Innes has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as Constable within the said County to supply the necessary constables by the failure of Lewis McRitchie qualify at odd times the said Samuel T. Innes shall well and truly discharge the duties of the office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein than the above obligation to be out of date to remain in full force and virtue
