This Indenture made and entered into the 12th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three Between Mills Pops and Margaret his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Harrison P. Pops of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mills Pops and Margaret for and in Consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said Harrison P. Pops at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Each granted Bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents each grant Bargain sell and Confirm unto him the said Harrison P. Pops his heirs and assigns forever One Certain Tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County Southampton containing Three hundred and thirty one acres be the same more or less adjoining the lands of Genl. John Bracken Richard Owen Nathan Pops et al: Together with all the right title interest Claim or demand of ground the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining: To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Harrison P. Pops his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Harrison P. Pops his heirs and assigns forever and his heirs Mills Pops and his wife Margaret Pops for themselves their heirs and assigns forever each hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Harrison P. Pops his heirs assigns administrators and assigns that they will by these presents received and given upon the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against the Claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever for Writings when of the said Mills Pops and Margaret Pops his wife have heretofore set their Names and affixed their seals the day and year first above written Signed sealed and entered
